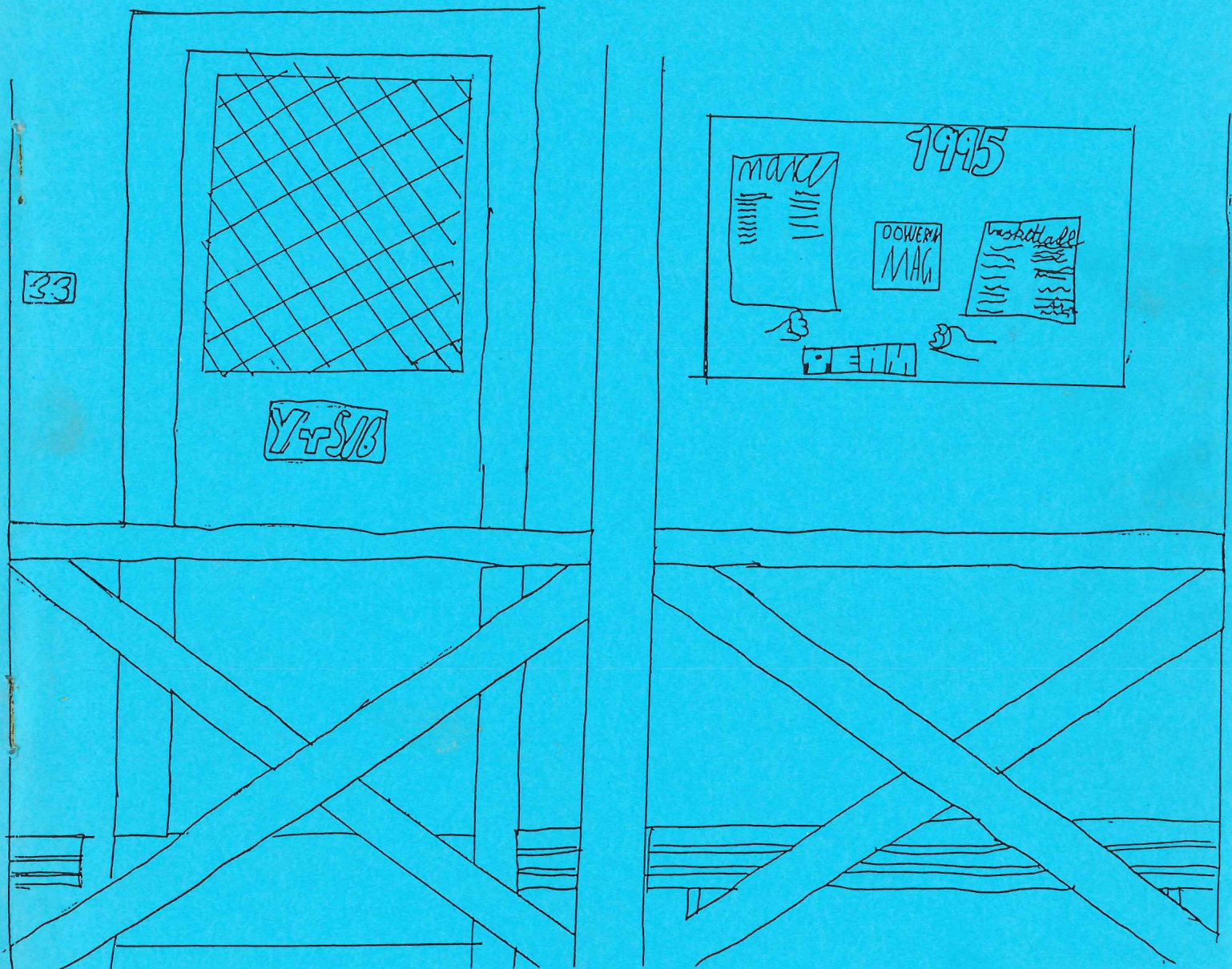
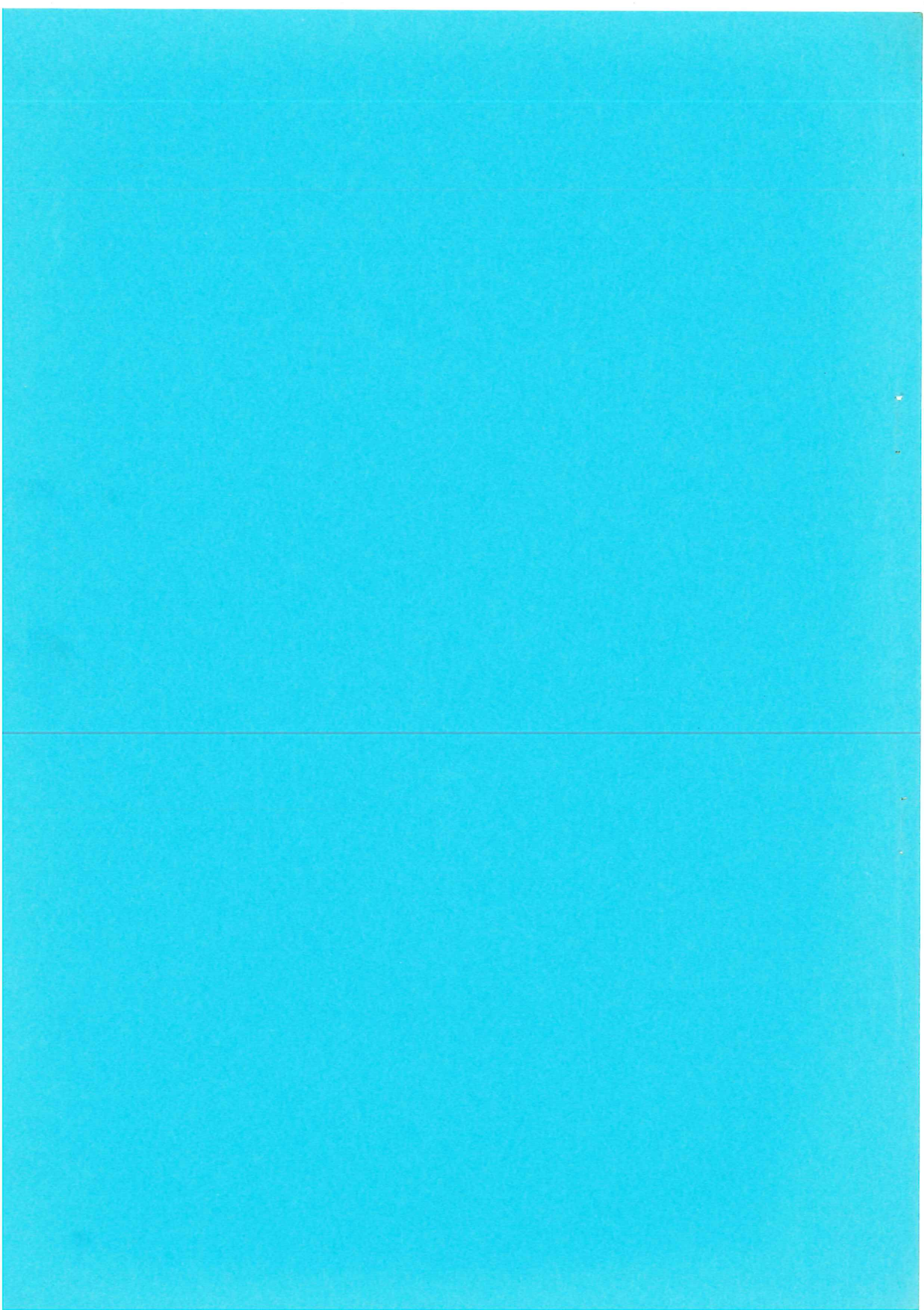

# DOWERIN

Every year is different with its own distinct highlights. Events/activities which stand out for me are:-

- Computer developments, Mr Bushell coordinated this project in updating both primary and secondary computers. Considerable money was expended by the P&C and the school and it has been great to see the enthusiasm displayed by students with the new equipment.
- A 'twilight' House Swimming Carnival was trialled in March and was a resounding success. It gave many parents, who normally wouldn't be able to attend, the opportunity to experience a school carnival.
- Dowerin is probably better known throughout the state as a result of the banner entered by the shire in the Local Government Week Competition. The year 9/10 Art class, under the direction of Mrs Brown, produced a beautiful banner which was displayed at Galleria Shopping Complex and in St Georges Terrace. Dowerin's entry was judged in the top 6 in a total of 84 shire entries from throughout the state.
- It is always rewarding to hear how our ex-students are when they continue their education elsewhere. Again, this year, we have received pleasing reports of the progress of ex-students.
- The school has, as always, been very much involved in the Dowerin Field Days. Students and staff provided great community service in a variety of catering and cleaning up activities, with the bonus of adding considerably to school funds. Mrs Quartermaine and her aerobic students put hours of work in to preparing for GWN's 'challenge of the schools' - their reward came in winning the competition and with it a new T.V. ( donated by J.K. Williams). Dowerin was responsible for organizing the Elders Art Competition involving some ten schools, and our school oval became tent land for the week.
- The secondary camp, with an 'outdoor education' theme, provided students with a wide range of new experiences. The years 6/7 are undoubtedly looking forward to their camp in 1996.

Above are just a few of what I saw as highlights in 1995. Everyone can probably remember others. The important thing is that 1995 has again been a productive year in the development of our students academically, socially and in sport. All credit to the students, to the school staff (both teaching and non-teaching), the P&C Association, and to the parents and Dowerin Community for all their support.

# DEPUTY PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

In writing this report for the 1995 School Magazine, it has provided an opportunity to reflect on the activities that Pre-primary to Year 7 students have been involved in throughout the year. 1995 has been marked by a year of industrial action in schools but in highlighting the achievements and programs that students have been involved in there has been little or no impact on the learning outcomes of students. This, I believe, is due to the commitment and dedication teachers have for their children's education.

The school year began with four primary classes and a pre-primary group. The only new primary staff member was myself. Interm swimming lessons crowded the first three weeks of the term with many children attaining the next level of swimming competence as an outcome. Forrest had an historic win in the Twilight Faction Carnival breaking a 10 year drought and proving the twilight program to be highly successful. Teachers were establishing classroom routines, homework diaries and beginning to introduce aspects of the primary school's three priorities - Current Affairs, Science and Editing during these beginning weeks. Interschool Swimming Carnival at Wongan Hills loomed quickly with our students achieving creditable individual performances and the Handicap Shield.

Easter and Anzac Services were significant events towards the end of Term 1 and helped to focus everyone on these two events which fell during Term 1 holidays. Kanga Cricket Carnival, Assembly and school photographs were other noteworthy events of Term 1 together with Term 1 Interim Reports and Test Packages.

Term 2 began smoothly with a group of academically talented children in Year 5 and 7 beginning a fortnightly PEAC program held alternately at Wyalkatchem and Dowerin. The main focus during Term 2 was WA Week with a range of whole school activities including a display of historical family items, tree planting near the Town Dam, sausage sizzle, tabloid games, WA town quiz and a colouring competition. The exceptionally wet week didn't manage to dampen spirits though. Other notable activities included assemblies, University of NSW Science Competition, football clinics and a visiting show - Myth-on-Theatre. Term 2 ended with children taking home Semester 1 reports and Test Packages.

Field Days and athletics helped to fill an exceptionally busy Term 3. A revamped Winter Lightning Carnival saw Dowerin DHS represented by netball teams and a football team at Goomalling mainly by Years 5-7 students. The day of competition was greatly enjoyed with 'A' netball team winning the Mortlock A Pool competition and football team coming runners-up. In addition to many children visiting the Dowerin Machinery Field Days, Mrs Linda Quartermaine, with support from other staff, trained an enthusiastic group of aerobic performers who competed successfully in GWN's Challenge of the Schools resulting in them being awarded a colour television for the school.

Athletics occupied most of Term 3 sports program and culminated with the athletics interhouse competition in mid-September. This time it was Stirling who won the closely

competed carnival with many fine individual performances being witnessed throughout the carnival. A long drive to Dalwallinu ten days later saw us competing as a school in the Interschool Athletics Carnival. Primary were able to, through team effort, achieve the Handicap Shield. Other notable highlights of Term 3 included two cultural shows, Hoopla and Wally Stanaforte Magician, students competing in Westpac and University of NSW Mathematics and Primary English Competitions, football clinics, Trivia Challenge and two assemblies. Term 3 ended with everyone feeling tired and jaded. Interim Reports and Test Packages were taken home on the last day.

The splitting of the Year 3/4 class into two year classes and the appointment of Miss Cathie Eckersley set up students for a good final term with extra staff and smaller classes. This reorganisation coincided with the postponed Interhouse Cross Country competition being held. Grit and determination were the two characteristics shown by most competitors with Forrest winning by the smallest of margins. As I write this report it is difficult to believe that there is only a few weeks left in the term and already end of year preparations and 1996 planning are well under way.

In summary it can be seen that the year has been very busy and children have been actively engaged in a broad range of activities, in addition to everyday classroom programs. Editing, Current Affairs and Science focus together with the new computers purchased jointly with the P&C has greatly enriched children's learning opportunities. This involved a lot of planning, time and effort with the help of Mr Girod during Vocational Education.

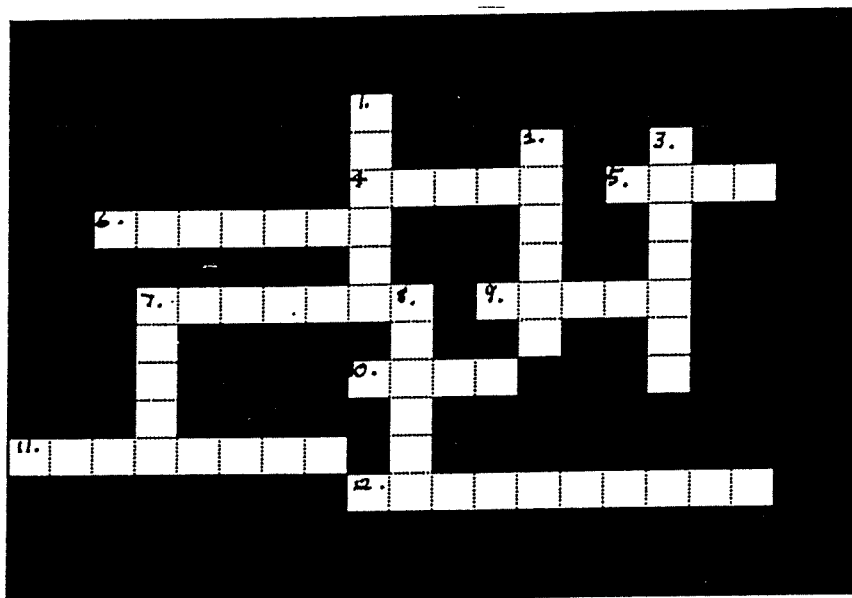
