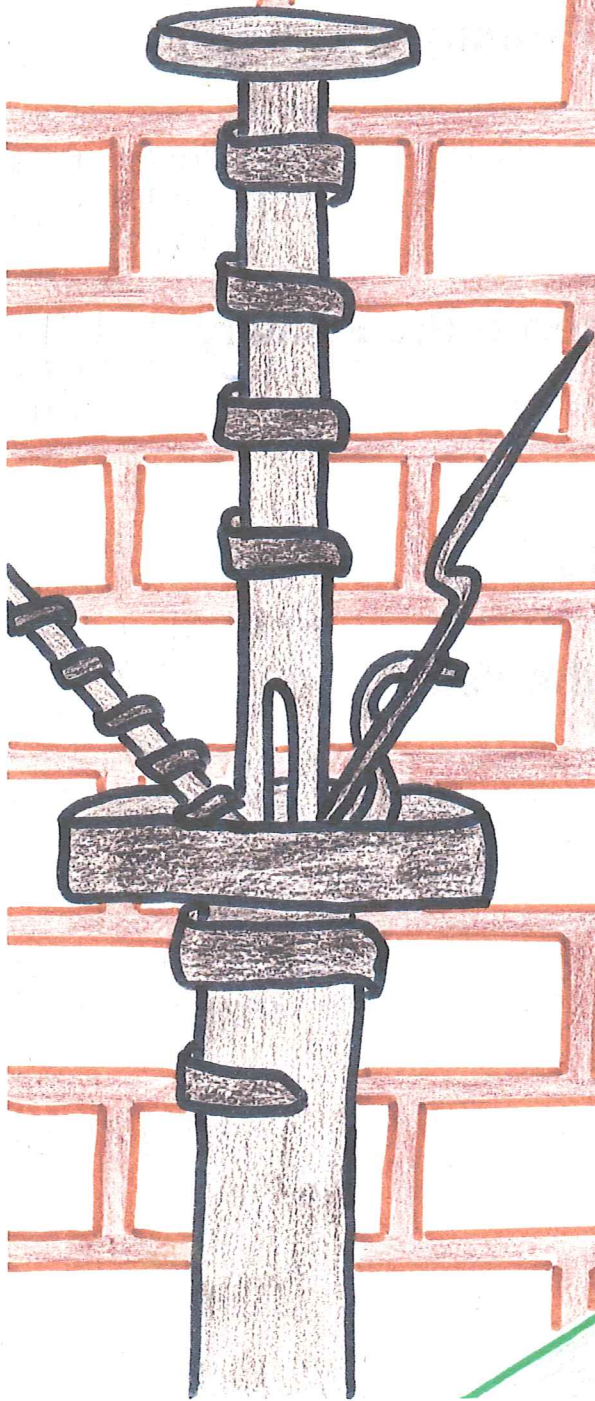

Sustainability

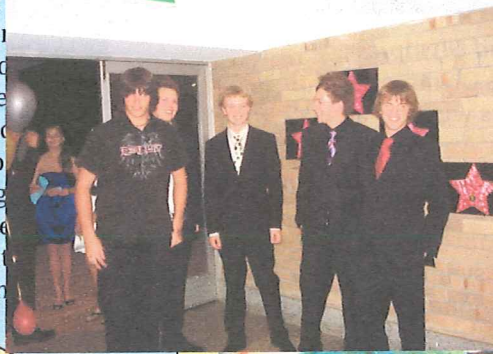

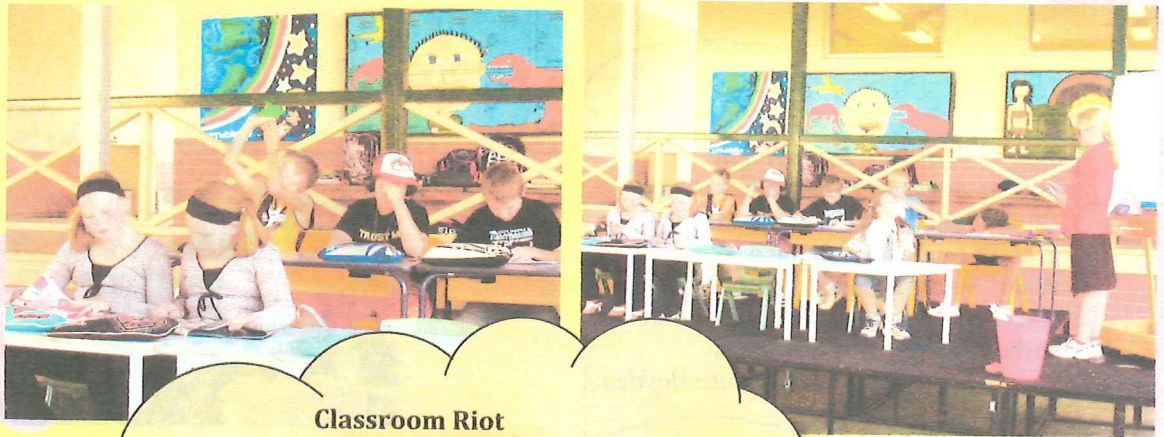

China and Olympics

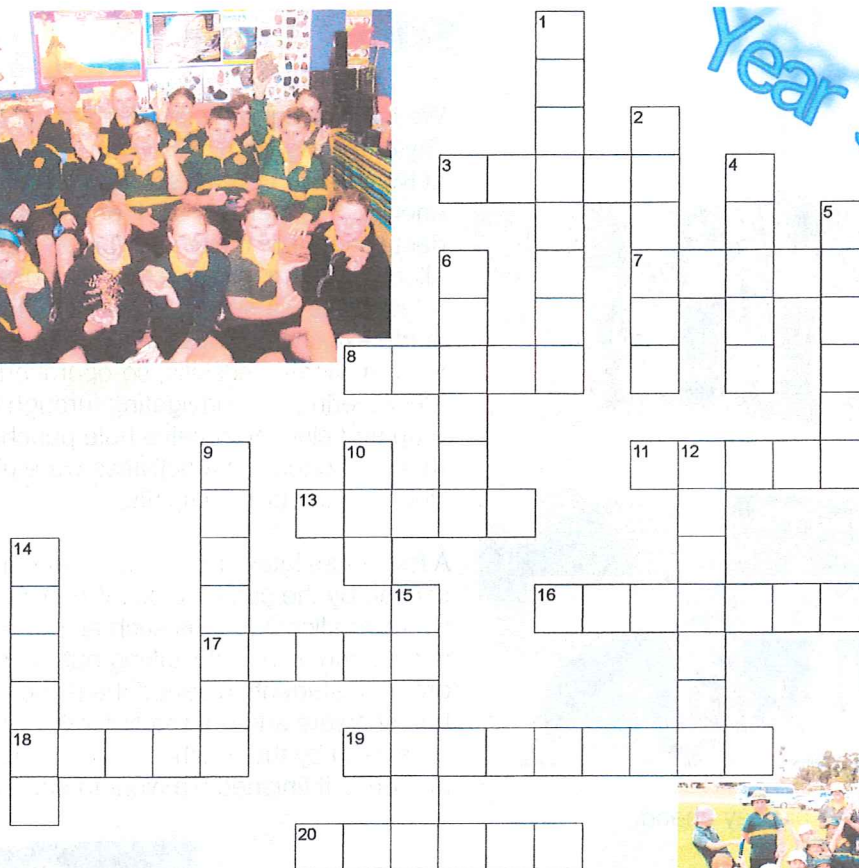

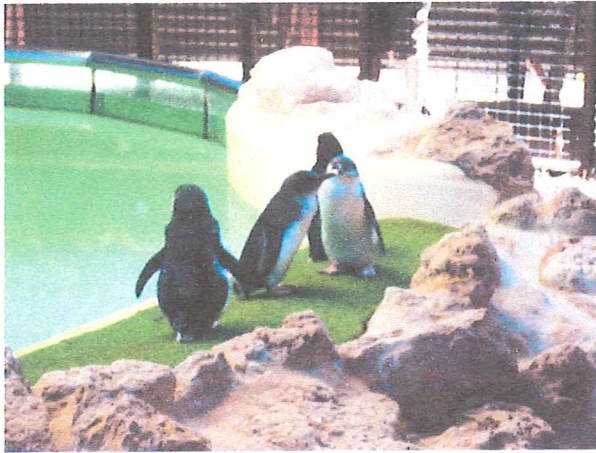
for the big day ahead.
