My name is Luke Schulze, and I will be teaching English in the senior school for Term 3.


I've worked at numerous schools across Western Australia in different roles. It has been fantastic to get to know the school community over the past couple of weeks and wonderful to be involved with the broader community.

### Year 7

The Year 7 students have been looking at *The Lost Thing* by Shaun Tan and creating a storyboard based on a segment of the short movie. Students have viewed the movie and have planned to reorganise a series of shots to tell an aspect of the story and visualised how everything fits together. 


### Year 8

The Year 8 students are reflecting on the technical codes used in the creation of disaster movies, and are creating their proposal for a disaster movie of their creation. We have had some exciting premises about all types of disasters from avalanches to destructive meteors. The class has particularly enjoyed working on names for archetypal characters such as side-kicks and mentors.

### Year 9 and 10

While the Year 9 and 10 students are creating a short answer analysis based on the selection of a still shot from a visual text of their choice. Students have quickly become adept with building their visual vocabulary and how the combination of SWAT (symbolic, written, audio and technical) codes are the building block for an audience to understand any visual text.
