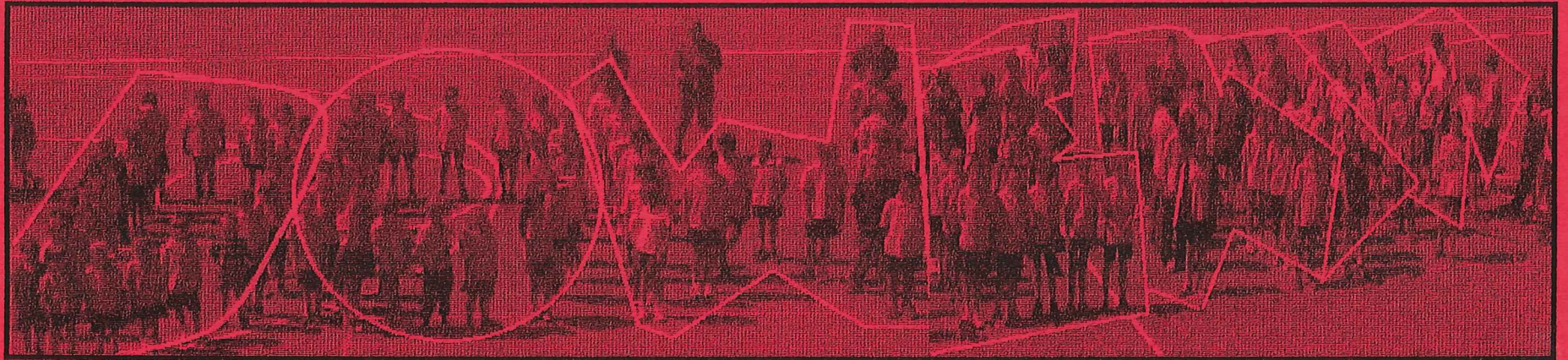

STUDENT LEADERS REPORT

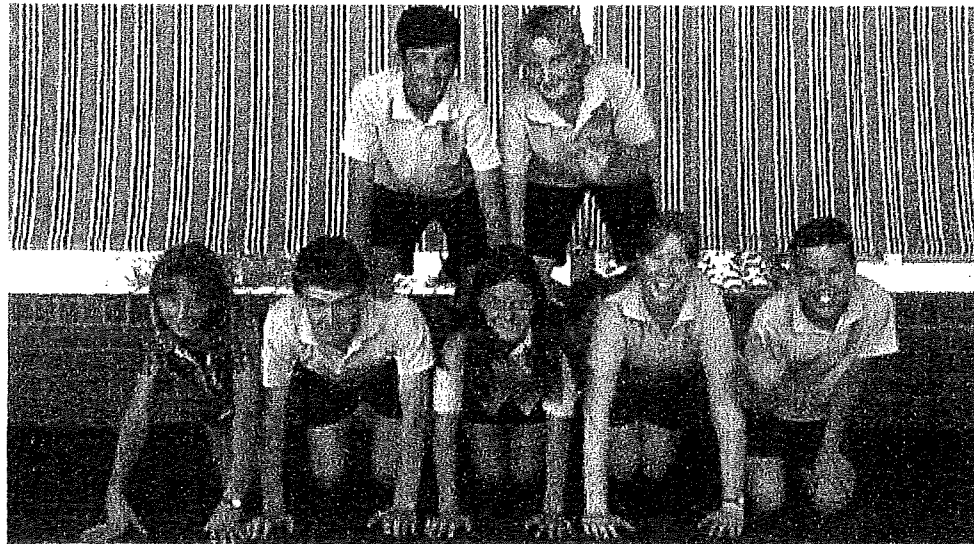
As student leaders our job is to ensure there is a healthy and happy relationship between students and staff. We are a student voice and try best to communicate ideas the students have about making the school a better place.

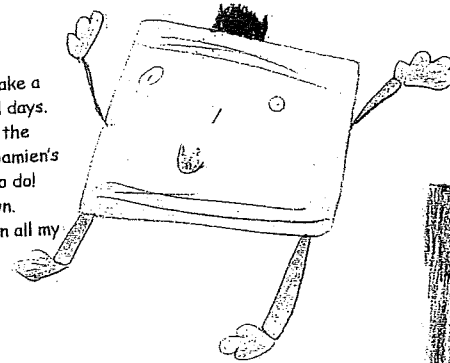
The Smasher

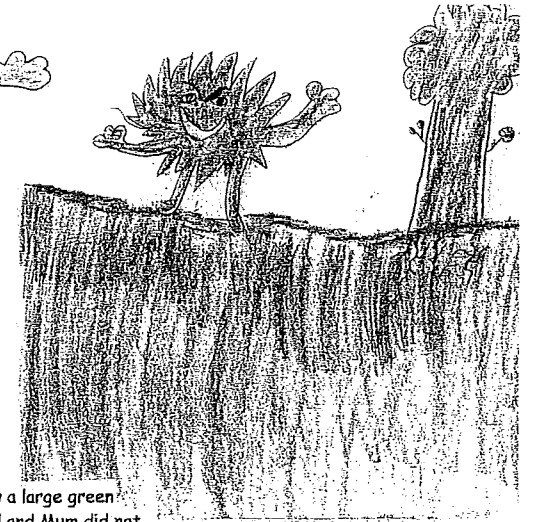

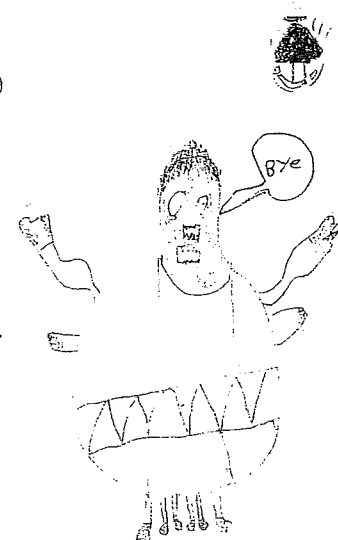

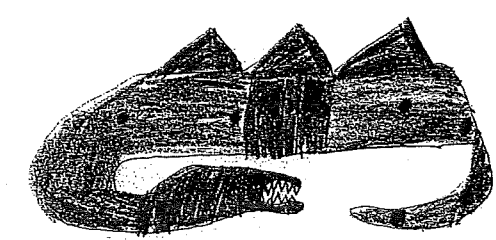
The Bed Eater

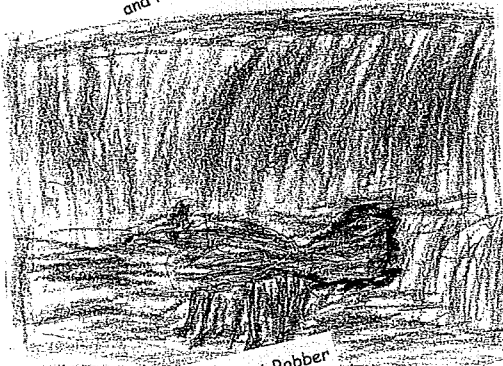
THE DOG-WALKING MACHINE

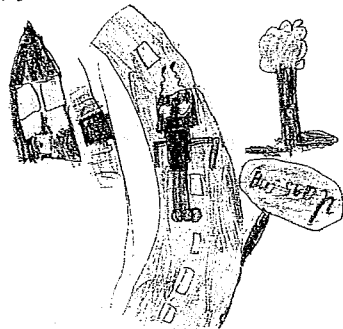
The Food Fetching Fox

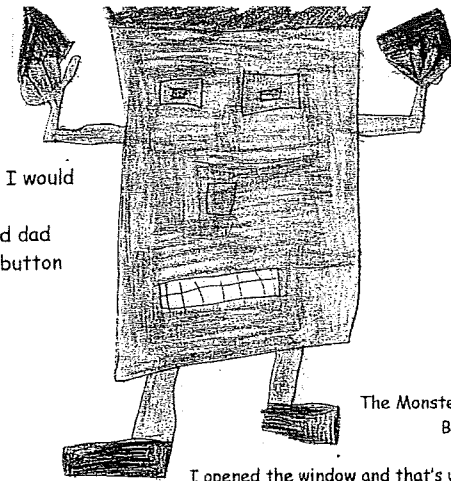
The Robot Robber

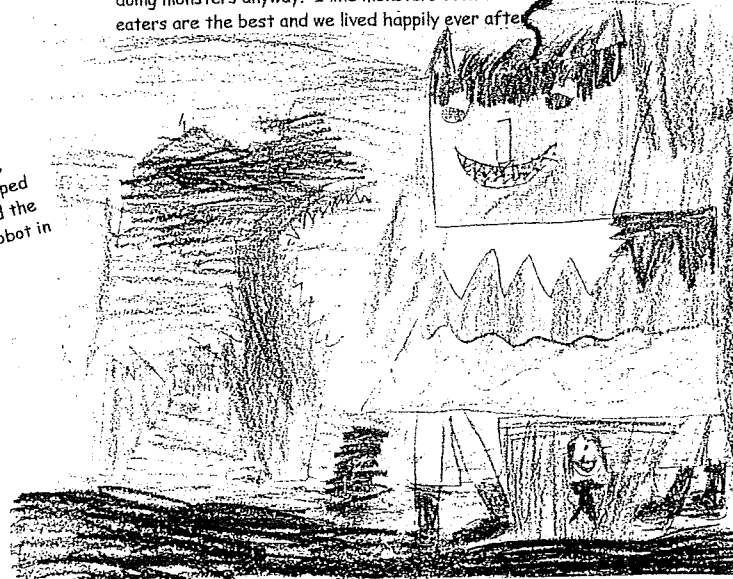


The Monster That Became My Friend

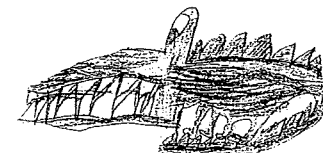
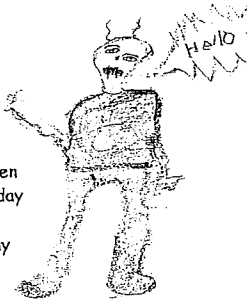
The Bed-Eater

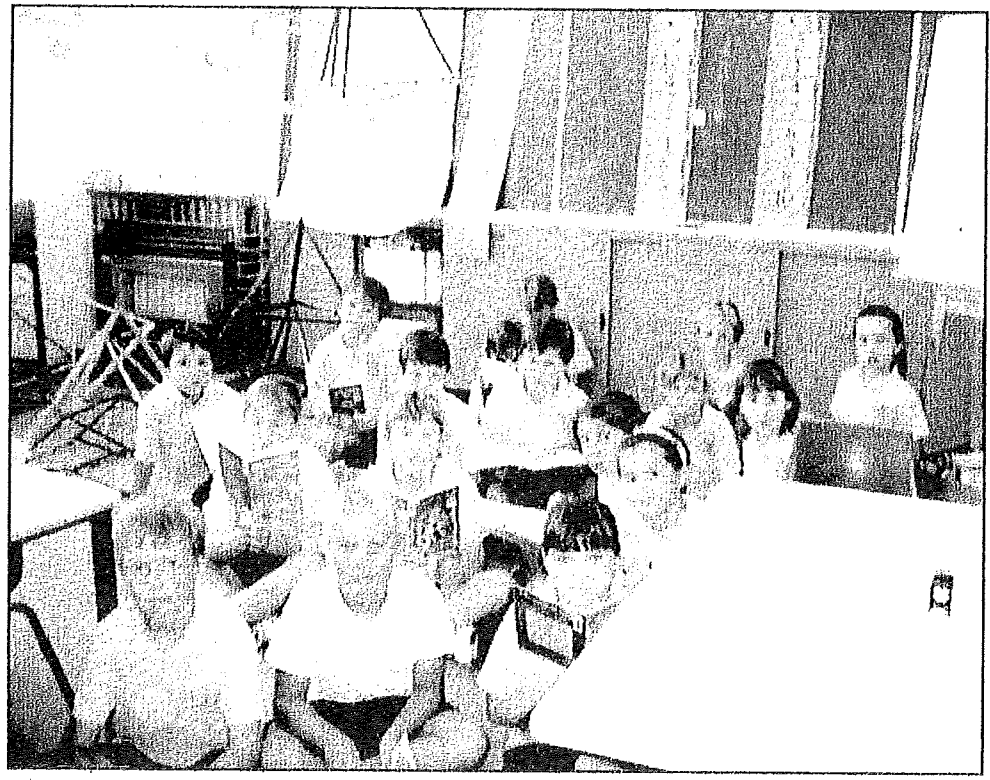
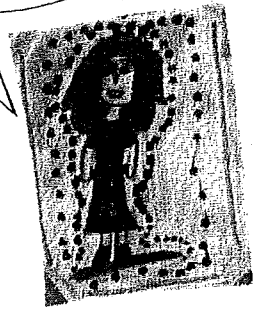
I liked it when we were learning about Greece, Egypt and the Olympics. I have got better at finishing my work. I really liked making a shield when we learning about Greece.

Overall the students thought that the whole experience was interesting and exciting. Many of them are quick to say that they would relive it if they could.



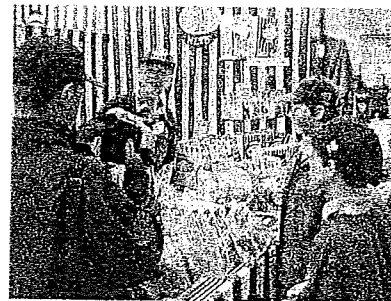
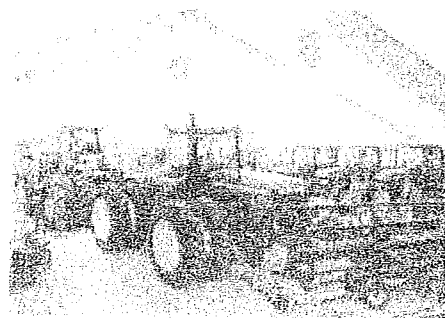
Field Days

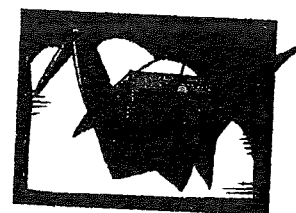

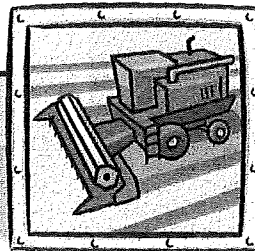
Farm Skills Report

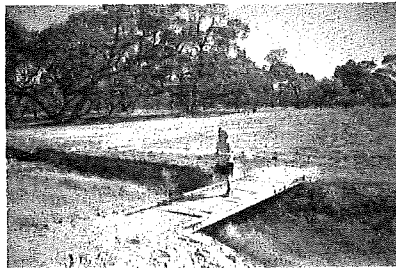
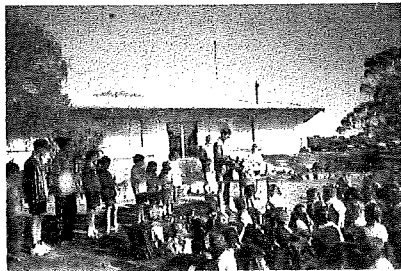
